Eligibility

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Highlights

- TEGL 10-23 Change 2 “Work Authorization Verification in Grant Programs Administered by Employment and Training Administration.”
- Clarifies which services require pre-documented work authorization
- Provides updates on what to do if work authorization expires
- Just a reminder: Eligibility, such as right to work, never allows self-attestation

Highlights

- Work authorization must be verified prior to participant level services being provided
 - TEGL 19-16 Attachment II
- General rule: anything beyond a self service or information only services requires work verification
 - Removes the section on “what may or may not” be provided without work verification from the VWL

Highlights

- Participants with temporary work authorization must be assessed for continued work authorization at least every 3 months
- If a work authorization expires or is revoked, the participant must be exited.
- Systemic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) is a resource if staff can access it-if not Form I-9 documentations should be assessed
